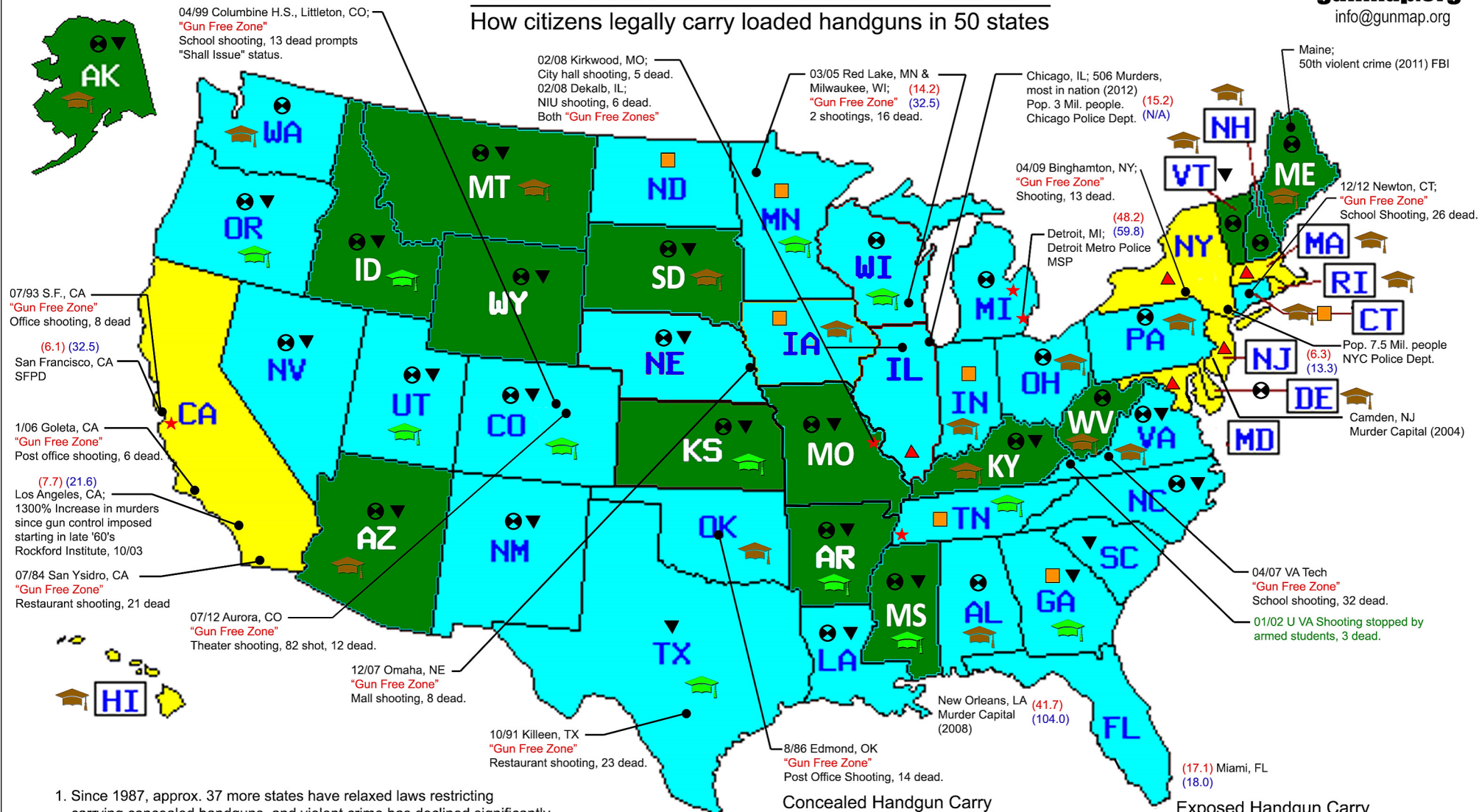

1. Since 1987, approx. 37 more states have relaxed laws restricting carrying concealed handguns, and violent crime has declined significantly.
2. Only 2 to 6% of those who may carry, choose to do so.
3. United States murder rate is 5.3 per 100,000 (2016)
4. Guns are used to stop 2.5 mil. crimes a year or 6,850 (Over 400 Rapes) times a day [Kleck].
5. (x.x) Murders per 100,000 people in 2015. (x.x) rapes per 100,000 people.
6. ★ (2016) 5 red stars = 5 most dangerous cities.
7. DE; legally "may issue plus," but does issue more liberally than most "shall issue" states.
8. ▼ States that allow loaded pistols in car w/ no permits (23).
9. Violent crime rates; USA, 387 per 100,000 (2014 FBI); Canada, 1190 per 100K (2012)

Concealed Handgun Carry

- "Constitutional Carry" - Unrestricted;
14 States; no permit required
- "Shall Issue" - 27 States; any law abiding adult who takes a one day class and passes a background check.
- "May Issue" - 9 States; arbitrary discrimination, must prove a need or be a celebrity, politician, or other royalty.

Right to Bear Arms on Campus

- Right Recognized and Protected
- Arbitrary Infringement Campus-to-Campus

Exposed Handgun Carry

- Unrestricted, no permit required - 33 states; subject to local ordinances and harassment.
- Exposed carry with permit only, 8 states.

Unconstitutional Firearm Tax Card

- ▲ Tax on right to keep arms, 4 states, D.C. & Cuba.
